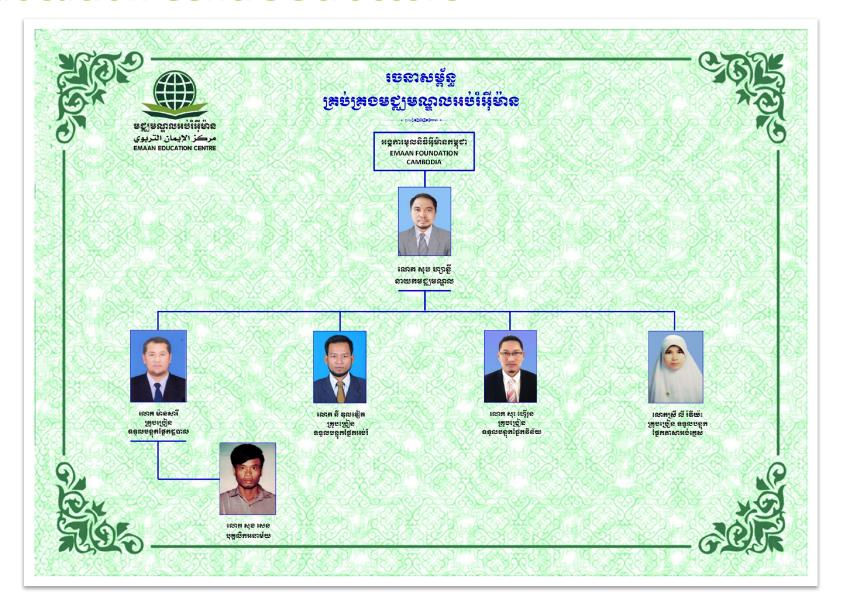

Emaan Education Centre Structure



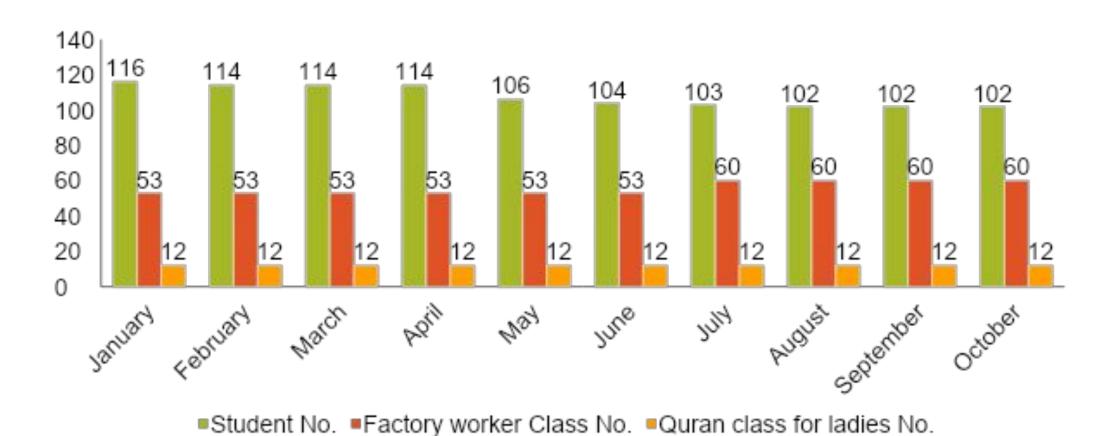

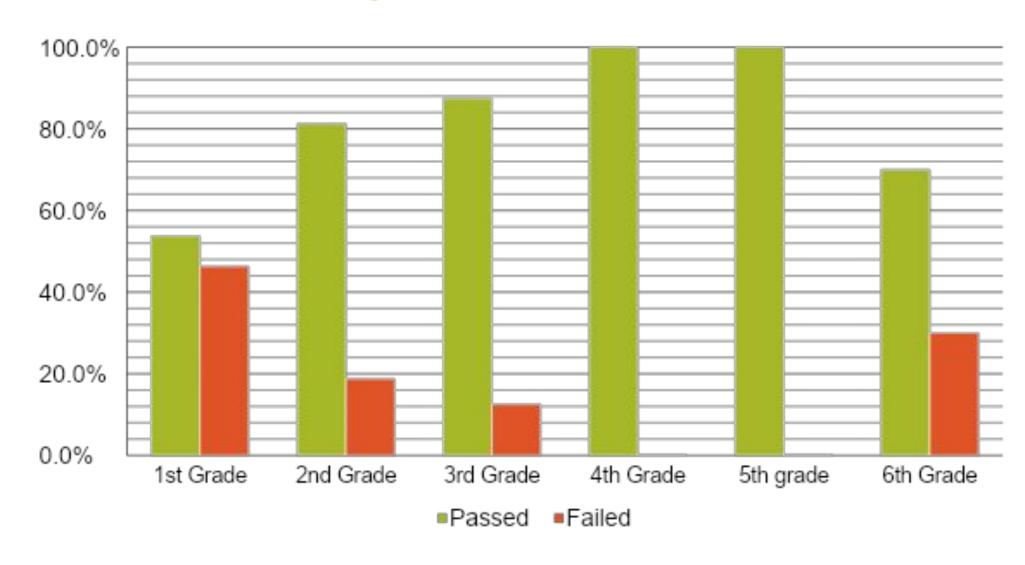

Enrollment 2022



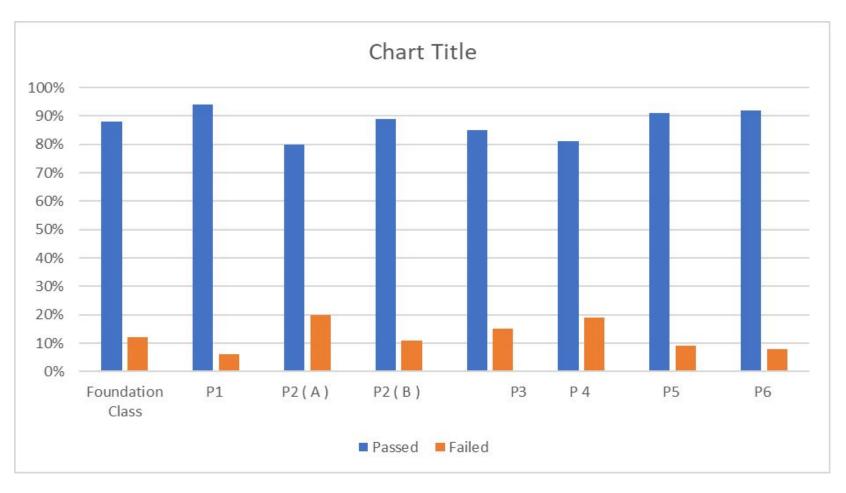


Academic Timeline

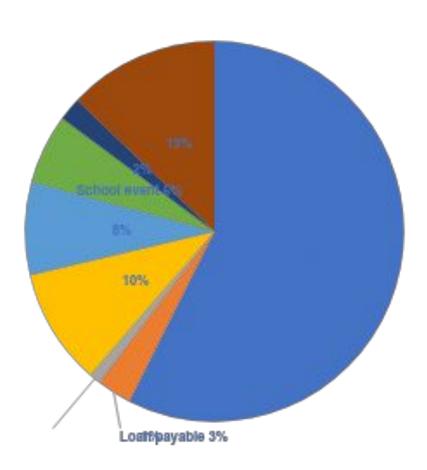
